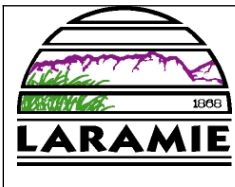

Setting public policy objectives each year ensures for the orderly and efficient operations of municipal government to accomplish the goals of the elected officials.

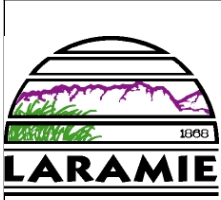
Background:
