Title: Resolution 2021-27, Appointing One (1) Member as the Traffic Safety Commission Appointee to the Urban Systems Advisory Committee

Recommended Council MOTION:

I move Council approve Resolution 2021-27, appointing Harold Colby to the Urban Systems Advisory Committee for a two (2) year term, expiring on August 6, 2023 and authorize the Mayor and City Clerk to sign.

Administrative or Policy Goal:

The City of Laramie under a Cooperative Agreement established a cooperative planning procedure for the Laramie Area Urban System Program. This agreement is between the City of Laramie, Albany County, the University of Wyoming and the Wyoming Department of Transportation. This agreement is intended to facilitate the participation of the Laramie area in the Urban System Program as administered by WYDOT. The agreement shall also facilitate cooperative planning and extension of the Major Street and Highway Plan outside the City corporate boundaries as permitted under Wyoming Statute §15-1-503(a).

Background:

On August 6, 2021, the term of one (1) Urban Systems Advisory Committee member appointed by the Laramie Traffic Safety Commission will expire. In accordance with the Cooperative Agreement, one (1) member shall be appointed as a Laramie Traffic Safety Commission representative.
