Title
2021 Wildland Fire Management Annual Operating Plan

Recommended Council MOTION: that Council approves the 2021 Wildland Fire Management Annual Operating Plan between the City of Laramie, Wyoming and the United States Forest Service; and authorizes the Fire Chief and Mayor to sign.

Administrative or Policy Goal:

To address issues affecting cooperation, interagency working relationships and protocols, financial arrangements, and joint activities between the signatories of the Wildland Fire Management Annual Operating Plan.

Background:

The City of Laramie Fire Department has participated in the Wildland Fire Management Annual Operating Plan for many years. The City of Laramie participation in this plan was originally through the Albany County Fire District #1 Operational Agreement, and for the last decade as its own entity. This is the tenth year that the City of Laramie will be a signatory agency to the agreement. The agreement addresses wild land fire season and interagency cooperation for wild land fire incidents that the City of Laramie Fire Department may respond to.

Legal/Statutory Authority:

The operating plan is prepared in accordance with the Wyoming Interagency Cooperative Fire Management Agreement USDA Forest Service, Bureau of Land Management, National Parks Service, Bureau of Indian Affairs, and the Fish and Wildlife Service.
