Title: Resolution 2021-25, authorizing the award of \$200,500 in Community Partner Funds Contingent on the Adoption of the Fiscal Year 2021/2022 Budget and on the Availability of Funds

Recommended Council MOTION:

I move to reconsider the motion to approve Resolution 2021-25, authorizing the award of \$200,500 in Community Partner Funds Contingent of the Adoption of the Fiscal Year 2021/2022 Budget and on the availability of funds.

Administrative or Policy Goal: N/A

Background:

During the March 9, 2021 work session, the 30 applicants for Fiscal Year 2021/2022 Community Partner funding made presentations to Council regarding their requests. At that meeting and in a memo sent to council, City Manager Janine Jordan, recommended that awards not exceed \$200,500. In turn, individual council members forwarded funding recommendations to staff.

The award amounts listed in Resolution 2021-25, reflect an average of each council members' recommendations for funding to individual agencies. The final award is contingent on the passage of this resolution, the adoption of the 2021/2022 budget, and the availability of funds.

Motion from April 6, 2021:

That council approve Resolution 2021-25, awarding \$200,500 in Fiscal Year 2021/2022 Community Partner funds in accordance with the amounts listed in the resolution, and authorize the Mayor and Clerk to sign.

Due to Councilor Stalder's recusal from voting on this item due to potential conflict of interest the total allocated to Hospice of Laramie was removed and reformulated to average their award based off the remaining eight (8) council members appropriation.
