Title: Resolution 2021-30, Setting an Open Container Area in the Downtown District

Recommended Council MOTION:

That City Council approve Resolution 2021-30, setting an open container area in the Downtown District, and authorize the Mayor and City Clerk to sign.

Administrative or Policy Goal:

City Council Goal A Holistic Economic Development (Laramie Centric) Milestone #2 Implement Improvement Program for Primary Retail Corridors that Considers Public-Private Partnerships and Development Policy

Background:

City Council approved Resolution 2020-41, creating an open container area in the Downtown District on July 7, 2020. Resolution 2020-56, requested an extension to the end date of the Open Container Area from September 7, 2020 to September 30, 2020 to match the Hollyhock Commons area availability. No major concerns arose from law enforcement from last year's open container area.

The resolution will create an open container area in the Downtown District according the Attachment A on Thursdays, Fridays, and Saturdays running from the Thursday prior to Memorial Day through the last Saturday of September, between the hours of 11:00 am and 8:00 pm. Liquor license types allowed to sell alcoholic or malt beverage for off-premise consumption include retail liquor license, microbrewery permits, and winery permits in accordance with Wyoming State Statute.
