Title:	Electrical Transformer Box Mural Project Presentation.				

Recommended Board Motion:

I Move that the Parks, Tree and Recreation Advisory Board approve of the Electrical Transformer Box Mural Project and recommend that staff work to support it with the appropriate City Departments.

Administrative or Policy Goal:

To support the dissemination of Public Art throughout the community in support of the City adopted Laramie Public Art Plan adopted in 2015.

Background Information:

Since 2013 when the City began the development of a Public Art Plan, staff has worked with the local community in various ways to support Public Art. This project will help bring small art interventions to five new locations in the community in unexpected locations. The following are the priority locations for 2021. Two of the locations are owned by WYDOT and three are City owned.

- 1) City hall--4th ST & Ivinson Avenue
- 2) Washington Park SW corner--Sheridan & 18th St corner
- 3) Big D--30th St & Grand corner
- 4) TnT Motorsports—Colorado Avenue & Snowy Range Road
- 5) Snowy's Shell--15th St & Reynolds St

The Laramie Public Art Coalition is working with WYDOT to implement the mural wraps in the proposal this evening on the two electrical transformer boxes that they own in keeping with projects in other nearby communities such as Rock Springs and Fort Collins. Recreation Staff are currently working with Public Works Staff to develop a Memorandum of Understanding to bring similar murals to the three electrical transformer boxes owned and maintained by the City in the locations presented.

If this project is successful additional mural wraps will be installed at other locations throughout the community.
