Recreation Division - Walls are going up in the administrative area of the Recreation Center. Construction has been pushed back some as conditions were discovered during demolition that require some additional design work to install turnstiles. Construction is still estimated to complete this summer. Summer activity registration opens on Saturday, May 1 and activities are available for viewing at www.cityoflaramie.org/activities This year we have begun to transition to an all online system for activity promotion and registration. This included a mailed post-card with important dates and information about our upcoming seasonal activities. The Ice & Event Center is now transitioning to summer programs as we will again be hosting summer camp in this venue. Electric drops will be installed to enable more activities to be hosted in the facility that require significant electrical use. Summer Camp registration opened on April 20th and went very well. Most sessions are close to full registration. Any additional available sessions can be found and registered for at www.cityoflaramie.org/summercamp. Recruitment for Aquatics staff continues as summer approaches. Lifeguard, Lifeguard Instructor and Water Safety Instructor classes will be conducted and interested participants can enroll on the www.cityoflaramie.org/activities webpage under "certification classes." A full complement of youth sports activities are planned for the summer including Little Kickers, Little Sluggers and Jr. Cowboys Football. These will be conducted with minimal modifications for Covid this summer due to outdoors venues. The outdoor aquatic facilities open on June 7th, pending nice weather. Three sessions of swim lessons are also planned with some limitations on capacities due mostly to staffing constraints. Additional outdoors events such as "Christmas in July" are also planned in the Aquatics section. Check www.cityoflaramie.org/activities for information and availability. Membership Promotions are also underway with a week of free fitness classes to non-members this week of May 26-30. Additionally, we will be rolling out a "Summer Pass" this season with special post-pandemic pricing to entice people back to the facility. Stay tuned for more exciting incentives in the months to come! We are also planning some fun changes to adult sports to adapt to the changing times. Stay tuned for "Spike Ball" and new softball programs that will focus more on the social aspect of adult sports as folks getting out post-pandemic.
