To Laramie City Clerk and Laramie City Council;

O'Dwyer's Public House would like to hold events on our property that allow patrons to carry out alcohol from our building to our parking lot (across the alley). We would cordon off a portion of our parking lot and allow customers to engage in outdoor activities e.g. playing cornhole. We would post signs restricting the alcohol consumption area to the designated area and we would have staff monitoring the activities in the parking lot. Our control scenario will have a greater density of monitoring than what will occur in the downtown open-container zone. We are requesting an open-container pass through zone for the alley separating our building from our southern parking lot (see attached) from June 15, 2021 until Nov 1, 2021 from 11 am to 10 pm everyday.

The designations will allow us flexibility in holding events on our property to attract customers. We view this as parallel to allowing people in the downtown open-container zone being able to go to the picnic areas/parks and entertaining themselves. We feel that the downtown open container zone, while good for downtown, will draw people away from our business. This request allows us to be somewhat competitive.
