Title

Memorandum of Understanding between the City of Laramie, Wyoming and the University of Wyoming for the purpose of providing additional Emergency Medical Services

Recommended Council MOTION:

“that Council approves the Memorandum of Understanding between the City of Laramie, Wyoming and the University of Wyoming for providing additional emergency medical services during the University of Wyoming athletic and special events as requested for the 2021-2022 season (August 1, 2021-June 30, 2022); and authorize the Mayor and City Clerk to sign”

Administrative or Policy Goal:

To provide effective and timely emergency medical response for the citizens and visitors to the City of Laramie through cooperative relationships with outside agencies.

Background:

The City of Laramie and the University of Wyoming have an ongoing relationship under which the City of Laramie Fire Department Emergency Medical Service (EMS) Division provides standby EMS services during University sponsored athletic events. The City of Laramie is compensated on an hourly basis for that service. This MOU establishes the terms and conditions under which the City of Laramie Fire Department provides those additional emergency medical services during the listed time frame as requested. The hourly rate agreed upon for the 2021-2022 season is at \$135.00/hour, which reflects a \$5.00/hour increase over last season.

Legal/Statutory Authority:

The City of Laramie is authorized and licensed by the State of Wyoming Office of Emergency Medical Services; certifying that the City of Laramie Fire Department has met the legal requirements for operating a Paramedic Level Ambulance Service in the State of Wyoming.
