



**Agenda Item: Resolution**

**Title: Resolution 2021-52, Appointing One (1) Member to the Traffic Safety Commission**

**Recommended Council MOTION:**

I move to approve Resolution No. 2021-52, appointing Lisa Rich to the Traffic Safety Commission and authorize the Mayor and City Clerk to sign.

**Administrative or Policy Goal:**

To further the City's need for advice and recommendations regarding pedestrian and vehicular safety and efficiency, as specified in the Laramie Municipal Code.

---

**Background:**

There are currently three (3) vacancies on the Traffic Safety Commission. Advertising has occurred to fill these positions with one application being received during the most recent advertising period.

On July 13, 2021 Councilors Erin O'Doherty and Jayne Pearce interviewed one (1) applicant and hereby recommend Lisa Rich to be appointed with a term expiring January 1, 2022. In accordance with the Laramie Municipal Code, City Council must make appointments to the Traffic Safety Commission.

Advertising continues in order to fill the remaining vacancies.

**Legal/Statutory Authority:**

Laramie Municipal Code: Chapter 10.08 Official Traffic Commission.

Laramie Municipal Code: Section: 10.08.010 stating: "The city council may, by a majority vote, remove any member of the official traffic commission whenever it appears that such removal would be in the best interests of the city, as determined by the city council, and shall fill vacancies created by the resignation, death or removal of any member."
