If the disc lands on the opposite side of the creek from the pin placement, the lie is played from the point in which it crossed. Same rule applies if the disc crosses out of bounds and does not return inbounds. Refer to tee signs for rules pertaining to each hole.

#### 1 PLAY SMART

Never throw into a blind area or when players, spectators, pedestrians, or other facility users are within range. Use a spatter.

#### 2 RESPECT THE COURSE

Observe all posted rules. No drinking, graffiti, or abuse of equipment or plants.

#### 3 REPRESENT THE SPORT

Be positive and responsible. Teach others.
