Title: LICENSE: Temporary use of Albany County Liquor License from Cavalryman Steakhouse on October 15, 2021 from 6-9 pm located at the UW Engineering Education and Research Building for a Blue Cross Blue Shield Reception

Recommended Council MOTION:

That City Council approve temporary use of an Albany County Liquor License for Cavalryman Steakhouse, for an alcohol catering permit to locate their license within city limits for a reception located at UW EERB (Engineering Education and Research Building), 1000 E University Avenue, Laramie, WY on October 15, 2021 from 6:00 pm to 9:00 pm for a Blue Cross Blue Shield Reception.

Administrative or Policy Goal:

To fulfill the legal requirements of the Wyoming State Liquor Laws.

Background:

The City Clerk’s Office received the attached Alcohol Catering Permit application on September 16, 2021, from Cavalryman Steakhouse requesting to secure permission to locate their Albany County liquor license within city limits.

Cavalryman Steakhouse is catering a reception for Blue Cross Blue Shield located at the UW Engineering Education and Research Building (EERB) 1000 E University Avenue, Laramie, WY on October 15, 2021 from 6:00 pm to 9:00 pm.

The Albany County Commissioners are set to approve the temporary relocation of this license at their October 5, 2021 meeting.

Legal/Statutory Authority:

As per Wyoming State Statute 12-4-502(d) “. . . Any applicant applying for a permit authorized by this section and having licensed premises located within a jurisdiction other than that jurisdiction that to which application is made, shall secure the written approval of the licensing authority of the jurisdiction in which the licensed premises are located prior to filing an application for a permit.”
