



**Agenda Item: Resolution**

**Title: Resolution 2022-29, Appointing One (1) Member to the Traffic Safety Commission**

**Recommended Council MOTION:**

I move to approve Resolution No. 2022-29, appointing Max Weiss to the Traffic Safety Commission and authorize the Mayor and City Clerk to sign.

---

**Administrative or Policy Goal:**

To further the City’s need for advice and recommendations regarding pedestrian and vehicular safety and efficiency, as specified in the Laramie Municipal Code.

---

**Background:**

There is currently one (1) vacancy on the Traffic Safety Commission. Diligent advertising has occurred by the City Clerk’s office to fill this position. Two applications were received during the most recent 4-week advertising period.

On April 19, 2022, Councilors O’Doherty and Pearce interviewed the two (2) applicants and hereby recommend Max Weiss for appointment.

The current vacancy has a term expiring January 1, 2023. It is asked of Council to approve the filling of this current vacancy with an extension of the standard 3-year appointment per the TSC by-laws to make Mr. Weiss’ new expiration January 1, 2026.

In accordance with the Laramie Municipal Code, City Council must make appointments to the Traffic Safety Commission.

**Legal/Statutory Authority:**

Laramie Municipal Code: Chapter 10.08 Official Traffic Commission.

Laramie Municipal Code: Section: 10.08.010 stating: “The city council may, by a majority vote, remove any member of the official traffic commission whenever it appears that such removal would be in the best interests of the city, as determined by the city council, and shall fill vacancies created by the resignation, death or removal of any member.”
