Title: LICENSE: Temporary Use of County Retail Liquor License for Cavalryman Steakhouse within City Limits on June 2, 2022 at Alice Hardie Stevens Center for StagePoint FCU Members Appreciation from 4:00 pm to 11:00 pm

Recommended Council MOTION:

That City Council approve temporary use of an Albany County Liquor License for Cavalryman Steakhouse, to locate their license within city limits for StagePoint FCU Members Appreciation located at the Alice Hardie Stevens Center on June 2, 2022 from 4:00 pm to 11:00 pm.

Administrative or Policy Goal:

To fulfill the legal requirements of the Wyoming State Liquor Laws.

Background:

The City Clerk’s Office received the attached Alcohol Catering permit application on May 13, 2022, from the Cavalryman Steakhouse requesting to secure permission to locate their Albany County liquor license within city limits.

The Cavalryman Steakhouse is catering a members appreciation event for StagePoint FCU located at the Alice Hardie Stevens Center 603 E University Ave, Laramie, WY on June 2, 2022 from 4:00 pm to 11:00 pm.

The Clerk’s office and city departments have approved the event and alcohol application. The Albany County Commissioners are set to approve the application at their May 17, 2022 regular meeting.

Legal/Statutory Authority:

As per Wyoming State Statute 12-4-502(d) “. . . Any applicant applying for a permit authorized by this section and having licensed premises located within a jurisdiction other than that jurisdiction that to which application is made, shall secure the written approval of the licensing authority of the jurisdiction in which the licensed premises are located prior to filing an application for a permit.”
