Title: Resolution 2022-41, Appointing a Council Member from the City of Laramie, Wyoming to Serve as a Council Liaison to the Albany County Mental Health Board

Recommended Council MOTION:

Background:

In 2017 the County Commissioners resolved to create the Albany County Mental Health Board. The Board’s purpose is to advance initiatives that improve the community’s response to mental health issues. In 2022, the bylaws of the Mental Health Board were revised to include a liaison from the City Council. The Board believes that the work they do can be more effectively passed on to Council members through a liaison. New bylaws were adopted on March 21, 2022, that includes the provision for the Board of County Commissioner and City Council to appoint a liaison to the Board.
