That City Council approve a temporary use of an Albany County Retail Liquor License Cavalryman Steakhouse at Alice Hardie Stevens Center on July 20, 2022, 4:00 to 10:30 pm, for an Ivinson Mansion Gathering.

Administrative or Policy Goal:

To fulfill the legal requirements of the Wyoming State Liquor Laws.

Background:

The City Clerk’s Office received the attached Alcohol Catering permit application on June 30, 2022, from Cavalryman Steakhouse requesting to secure permission to temporarily relocate their Albany County liquor license within city limits.

Cavalryman Steakhouse will be catering an Ivinson Mansion Gathering located at the Alice Hardie Stevens Center, 603 E Ivinson Ave, Laramie, WY on July 20, 2022 from 4:00 pm to 10:30 pm.

The Clerk’s office and city departments have approved the event and alcohol application.

Legal/Statutory Authority:

As per Wyoming State Statute 12-4-502(d) “. . . Any applicant applying for a permit authorized by this section and having licensed premises located within a jurisdiction other than that jurisdiction that to which application is made, shall secure the written approval of the licensing authority of the jurisdiction in which the licensed premises are located prior to filing an application for a permit.”
