

**CITY OF LARAMIE, WYOMING  
RESOLUTION 2022-45**

**RESOLUTION APPROVING ALBANY COUNTY'S SUBMISSION TO VOTERS  
OF CONTINUATION OF COUNTY LODGING TAX**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Wyo. Stat. § 39-15-204(a)(iii) "An excise tax not to exceed two percent (2%) upon retail sales of tangible personal property, admissions and services made within the county. The total excise tax imposed within any county under this paragraph shall not exceed two percent (2%). The revenue from the tax shall be used in a specified amount for specific purposes authorized by the qualified electors and as provided in W.S. 39-15-211 (b) (iv). Specific purposes shall not include ordinary operations of local government except those operations related to a specific project or as authorized by W.S. 39-15-203(a) (iii) (H)"; and

**WHEREAS**, Wyo. Stat. § 39-15-203(a)(ii)(D) states that, if the proposition is approved, the same proposition shall be submitted at subsequent general elections until the proposition is defeated; and

**WHEREAS**, the Albany County Commissioners have resolved to put on the November 8, 2022, General Election Ballot a continuation of the Albany County a two percent (2%) lodging tax upon the sales price paid for lodging services as they are defined by W.S. § 39-15-101(a)(i).

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF LARAMIE RESOLVES:**

1. The foregoing recitals are incorporated in and made a part of this resolution by this reference.
2. The City of Laramie hereby approves a lodging tax proposition for the November 8, 2022 ballot substantially as follows: "Shall the Board of Commissioners of the County of Albany, State of Wyoming be authorized to continue to impose, as allowed by Wyoming Statute, a two percent (2%) excise tax upon the sales price paid for lodging services within Albany County, the primary purpose of which is for local-travel and tourism promotion."
3. A copy of this resolution shall be forwarded to the Albany County Board of Commissioners and act as approval by the City of Laramie under W.S. § 39-15-203(a)(ii)(C) to place the proposition to continue the tax on the ballot.
