AN ORDINANCE AMENDING LARAMIE MUNICIPAL CODE CHAPTER 5.09 ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES
TO INCLUDE THE PROVISIONS FOR RETAIL LIQUOR LICENSES FOR COMMERCIAL SERVICE
AIRPORTS AND CORRECT LANGUAGE

WHEREAS, during legislative session this year the state approved House Bill 0055 amending Wyoming State Statute 12-4-201 to allow “retail liquor licenses issued to commercial service airports in incorporated cities or towns” which became effective on July 1, 2022,

WHEREAS, a small correction to language was found from changes resulting from House Bill 0013 in the 2021 legislative session.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF LARAMIE as follows:

Section 1. Shall be amend Section 5.09.400 and 5.09.455 to read as follows:

Chapter 5.09 - ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

5.09.400 - Retail liquor license—Generally.

A retail liquor license is the authority under which a licensee is permitted to sell alcoholic liquor or malt beverages for use or consumption but not for resale, except as otherwise provided in W.S. 12-4-201.

A. Retail liquor licenses issued to commercial service airports in incorporated cities or towns shall be exempt from the number restrictions in paragraphs (i) through (iii) W.S. 12-4-201.

5.09.455 - Restaurant license—Dispensation regulations. (W.S. Section 12-5-201 and W.S. Section 12-4-410)

A. Alcoholic and malt beverages shall be dispensed and prepared for consumption in one ~~room~~ area upon the licensed premises separated from the dining area in which alcoholic and malt beverages may be served. No consumption of alcoholic or malt beverages shall be permitted within the dispensing ~~room~~ area, nor shall any person other than employees over eighteen years of age be permitted to enter the dispensing areas.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall become effective on upon passage and publication.
