

**CITY OF LARAMIE, WYOMING
RESOLUTION 2022-52**

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING INSTALLATION OF A BUS STOP AND SCHOOL ZONE; REMOVAL
OF PARKING AND STRIPING OF 1400 BLOCK OF LEWIS STREET**

WHEREAS, the University of Wyoming has authorized a new dorm housing project in the area of 15th and Lewis St; and

WHEREAS, the vacation of the 1400 block of Lewis Street is needed to accommodate the project; and

WHEREAS, the K-8 Lab School is located within the College of Education adjacent to the project site; and

WHEREAS, safe access to the Lab School for K-8 students and parents must be maintained.

NOW THEREFORE THE CITY COUNCIL OF LARAMIE, WYOMING RESOLVES:

Section 1. City shall install a bus loading zone with appropriate signage on the south side of Lewis Street in the remaining unvacated section of Lewis Street.

Section 2. City shall install an appropriate school zone north of the Lab School as determined by City Engineering, including signage and flashing beacons/speed limit signage.

Section 3. The University of Wyoming shall install appropriate striping and signage and remove on street parking on the 1400 Block of Bradley Street as recommended by the Traffic Impact Study to accommodate increased traffic to the Lab School. Final striping plan must be approved by City Engineer and will be maintained by the City.

Section 4. City shall amend the budget as appropriate to accommodate this resolution.

Section 5. The University shall remove the left and right turn lane on 15th Street at the 15th Street and Lewis Street intersection and install double yellow lines establishing two directional travel on 15th.
