

Letter Confirming Cooperation for University of Wyoming Phase 1 Dorm Construction

In conjunction with Phase 1 UW Housing project, both entities have recognized and agreed that the following are important to maintaining safe access to the Lab School as well as general pedestrian and traffic safety in the area. Both the City and the University of Wyoming agree to carry out their responsibilities as soon as feasibly possible to accommodate safe access and Phase 1 construction of new dormitory buildings at UW.

- 1) City of Laramie will establish a school bus loading zone on Lewis as designated by the attached map of at least 170' west of the crosswalk at the intersection of Lewis and 14th street.
- 2) University of Wyoming will appropriately sign two parking spots for 30-minute lab school parent/visitor in the short-term parking lot adjacent to the Lab School.
- 3) UW and the City will work collaboratively to authorize restriping and necessary parking removal 1400 block of Bradley Street as recommended in the traffic study.
- 4) The City will initiate a 20mph school zone as appropriate to the north of the lab school.
- 5) University of Wyoming will replace the existing cross walk on the west side of the 14th and Lewis Street intersection with a more durable thermoplastic material. The City of Laramie will maintain said crosswalk after installation.
