



Agenda Item: Agreement

Title: Consideration of a Professional Services Agreement with Eldorado Wall Company for the purchase and installation of climbing equipment at the Laramie Recreation Center.

Recommended Council motion:

I move that Laramie City Council approve the Professional Services Agreement with Eldorado Wall Company for the sole source purchase and installation of two Kinetix Climbing Towers and the purchase of wall climbing panels and safety pads in an amount not to exceed \$60,695.93 and authorize the City Manager and Clerk to sign.

Administrative or Policy Goal:

Resolution 2022-15 Section 2. D. Milestone #3--Continue Expansion of Green Belt, Park and Recreation Amenities.

Background:

When the remodel of the entrance and administrative area at the Laramie Recreation Center was undertaken we began making plans to create a new space that would enable individuals of all ages to engage in new activities. The space we are planning to utilize is in the Grand Hall outside the West Court at the Recreation Center.

Staff solicited requests for quotes and proposals in the Fall of 2020 hoping to engage a company to assist with the design and implementation of our vision. We received three proposals which had elements that would be appealing to members, and explored options submitted from Eldorado Wall Company. The ultimate layout and equipment purchased is manufactured and distributed by their company and not available through other companies. This agreement is for a sole source purchase.

Eldorado has engineered and will install the climbing towers. The climbing wall panels will be installed by staff. This purchase is the first phase of a larger project that we anticipate will include some additional e-sports activities, seating, lighting, and paint. The overall update to the area will provide for a wide range of ages to engage with healthy activities.

Additionally, it helps us implement recommendations outlined in the Laramie Recreation Center Facility Performance Analysis. This project touches on three Aims;

- Perception—with new equipment responsive to the influx of new young people in the facility.
- Outreach—enhancing participation among a group of citizens (twens) who currently have limited activity options in the facility.
- Operations—utilizing an under-programmed space for synergistic activity.
