



Agenda Item: Surplus Equipment - Declaration

Title: Consideration of a declaration of surplus equipment at the Laramie Community Recreation Center.

Recommended Council MOTION:

I move that Council declare the five Softplay indoor playground climbing features as surplus, authorize staff to offer them for sale to the public and authorize the City Manager and Clerk to sign the bid announcement.

Administrative or Policy Goal:

Staff Goal: Maintain quality facilities and equipment for use by Recreation Center patrons.

Background:

The equipment offered for sale has been decommissioned with the remodel of the Laramie Recreation Center. These pieces of climbing equipment are intended for toddlers and originally cost \$3,000-\$5,000 each. Since they will not be able to be re-utilized in the new climbing area due to space constraints, the Parks and Recreation Department would like to declare them as surplus and offer them for sale on "Public Surplus" an online auction platform and sold to the highest bidder.

Softplay items being offered:

- Aligator
- Beaver
- Bridge
- Hippo
- Log

The estimated value of the used cardio fitness equipment is estimated to be between \$2,500-\$5,000.
