Title: Grant Award from Assistance to Firefighters Grant (AFG) in the amount of \$30,940.90 with a City of Laramie match of \$3,094.10 for a total project budget of \$34,035.00

Recommended Council MOTION:

“that Council accepts the Grant Award from the Assistance to Firefighters Grant (AFG) program in the amount of \$30,940.90 requiring a City of Laramie match of \$3,094.10 for a total project budget of \$34,035.00 for the purpose of funding Incident Command, Safety Officer, and Live Fire Instructor Certification training; and authorize to amend the 2022 – 2023 COL fiscal budget.”

Administrative or Policy Goal:

To deliver quality certified training programs to LFD staff enhancing the overall safety of emergency operations.

Background:

The City of Laramie Fire Department was authorized by Council on December 21, 2021 for application to the FEMA – Assistance to Firefighters Grant (AFG) program. The project amount requested was in the amount of \$167,328.00 to support certified training for firefighters and safety officers as well as replacing equipment within the department. The AFG program has announced a portion of the application to be awarded to the City of Laramie Fire Department for the purpose of funding Incident Command, Safety Officer, and Live Fire Instructor (NFPA 1403) Certification training. The total project cost is \$34,035.00 with a 90% Federal Share of \$30,940.90 and a required City of Laramie 10% match of \$3,094.10.
