Recreation Division –Adventure Kids is off to a great start! The activity is full, and they are enjoying the improvements to the Multi-purpose Room. September 30 is the first full day of activities for Adventure Kids. The Softplay items from the old childcare area have been posted for sale on the online auction site and we have some interested daycares in town. Swim lessons start up again in October and private lessons are currently underway. Pumpkin Dunkin’ is being sponsored this year by Uni-Wyo Credit Union and has been expanded to include other fun fall festival activities. The event will take place on the evening of October 21. The Adult Volleyball league has begun and continues to draw interested people. Youth Volleyball is particularly popular this year with over sixty participants. The Ice season is well underway. Skating lessons have started, and the Figure Skating Club is working to generate more participants and interest in hopes of eventually extending the ice season further into the spring. New Membership roll-out continues at the Recreation Center, and we are working to ensure accuracy and ease of use.
