



Agenda Item: Memorandum of Understanding

Title: Consideration to accept the Memorandum of Understanding between the Laramie Police Department and the Cheyenne Police Department.

Recommended Council MOTION:

I move that Council approve Wyoming Law Enforcement Extraterritorial Assistance Memorandum of Understanding, between the Laramie Police Department and the City of Cheyenne and authorize the Mayor and Clerk to sign.

Administrative or Policy Goal:

This recommendation aims to update the current Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between the City of Laramie Police department and the City of Cheyenne Police Department. The MOU provides both agencies access to additional resources to appropriately respond to emergencies or exceptional circumstances. Such situations may exceed the immediate staffing, skill, or equipment needs of any individual agency. The City of Cheyenne and the City of Laramie may need to seek the assistance of each other's law enforcement agency to provide certified peace officers for law enforcement services. Geographical boundaries of both parties to this agreement are located within the State of Wyoming, enabling each party to assist the other. This Memorandum of Understanding permits the parties to assign certified Wyoming peace officers for law enforcement services within the boundaries of the requesting jurisdiction.

Background:

The previous MOU does not reflect current information and updates were required. The new document reflects changes in leadership positions within the agencies and has been reviewed by legal counsel from both entities.
