
The LRRC Board of Directors has voted in to increase membership dues by 20% in early 2023. Per our lease we are required to first get approval from the City Manager.

We haven't raised membership dues in 8-10 years while our membership increased by 50%. We are seeing the effects of inflation and increasing maintenance related to infrastructure and higher usage. 8 years of 3.5% inflation = 32%, 10 years = 41%. Inflation alone in 2021 and 2022 was 16%. Not all our expenses are impacted by inflation but some are including:

Lumber, other building materials, crushed asphalt and concrete
Propane and electricity
Property and Liability Insurance
Bookkeeping, Accounting and Membership services
Contractor labor, heavy equipment rental, transportation and fuel,
Welding and metal fabrication consumables
Weed and erosion control
Paper and steel targets

In response we are requesting the City Manager approve a 20% increase. Our dues are still in line with clubs in Wyoming and Colorado. This increase will allow us to maintain the same levels of service while taking care of our facilities and creating new shooting opportunities. The following chart shows the proposed changes:
