



**Agenda Item: Bid Award**

**Title: Award of Bid: Unit 609 Landfill Water Truck (used)**

**Recommended Council MOTION:**

I move to award the bid for the Unit 609 Landfill Water Truck to Wyoming Machinery Company, Cheyenne, WY in an amount not to exceed \$146,500.00 and authorize the Mayor and City Clerk to sign.

**Administrative or Policy Goal:**

Replace aging and worn equipment according to the City’s established replacement schedule as recommended by the Fleet Advisory Committee and Public Works Department and approved in the biennial budget.

**Background:**

The City has an established replacement schedule for vehicles and equipment that identifies recommended vehicle and equipment replacement according to a schedule that considers age, mileage, operating hours, and life expectancy. The Fleet Advisory Committee has developed this replacement schedule over the last several years. The replacement schedule provides the recommendations in the annual budget adopted by City Council.

The Public Works Department, Solid Waste Division, has funding to purchase Unit 609 Landfill Water Truck. This unit was placed out for public bid and advertised according to the City’s Purchasing Policy. Bids were opened on September 6, 2022. No bids were received due to supply issues. Used water trucks were inspected from November through February to find a unit that will fit the needs of the landfill and aid in DEQ compliance for fugitive dust and fire suppression.

The Wyoming Machinery unit meets all specifications and has a delivery of 14 days from receipt of Notice of Award. This unit is a 348 Peterbilt Chassis, automatic Allison Transmission, with a 4,000-gallon water tank with 2 front and rear sprayers and a left-hand side sprayer. This water truck was the highest rated during the inspection process and has 1,620 hours on it and is a model year 2022.

The lower Tri State bid did not meet specifications as it is only a two axle, 2000-gallon tank.
