**Title:** Resolution 2026-14, supporting Albany County’s Submission of an Unmet Housing Grant Application to the State Loan and Investment Board

**Recommended Council MOTION:**

I move that the Laramie City Council approve Resolution 2026-14, supporting Albany County’s submission of an Unmet Housing Grant Application to the State Loan and Investment Board and authorize the mayor and clerk to sign.

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**Administrative or Policy Goal:**

Resolution 2025-13, Housing, identify infill opportunities to increase housing diversity within the core area of the city; identify land that could be acquired through conventional purchasing, land trusts, trades or development authorities to incentivize growth, while maintaining the city’s strong financial condition.

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**Background:**

The State Loan and Investment Board has released an Unmet Housing Needs grant. Albany County is applying on behalf of the Albany County Housing Land Trust for the Foundations for Scaling Up: West Side’s Workforce Housing Project. This resolution provides support for the application as well a commitment of 50% of the intended, not required, local match of 10%.

The funding if awarded is for the acquisition of land in the West Side generally east of Hodgeman Street, border by Gibbon St. on the north and Bradley Street on the south along with funding associated infrastructure improvement including, but not limited to roads, curb, gutter, sidewalk, water, and sewer related to the development in the area.
