Title: Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) Grant Agreement No. 3-56-0017-037-2019 for Federal Funding to Rehabilitate and Expand Terminal Building at Laramie Regional Airport.

Recommended Council MOTION:

I move to approve the FAA Grant Agreement No. 3-56-0017-037-2019 for federal funding to rehabilitate and expand the Terminal Building at Laramie Regional Airport, and authorize the Mayor and Clerk to sign.

Administrative or Policy Goal:

Support for the Laramie Regional Airport, which is a contractual partner to the City of Laramie.

Background:

The terminal building was constructed in 1960 and has exceeded its useful life and needs updated and replaced. Also, this project includes funding from Wyoming State Aeronautics and the local Capital Facilities Tax. The project will be completed late 2020.

This \$2,000,036 FAA grant is a 95% federal grant matched by 3% from the Wyoming State Aeronautics - \$63,159- and 2% Local match - \$42,106 – for a total project cost of \$2,105,301. The Airport will provide the entirety of the match through its own, but the FAA requires approval from both the City of Laramie and Albany County. By executing this agreement, the council is only endorsing this but is not committing any funds or other resources.
