



Agenda Item: Resolution

Title: Resolution 2019-75, to Reconstitute the Ad Hoc Community Alcohol Consumption & Best Practices Review Committee Two Years from the Completion of 2019 Committee to Review the Changes and Their Impacts.

Recommended Council MOTION:

I move to approve Resolution 2019-75, to Reconstitute the Ad Hoc Community Alcohol Consumption & Best Practices Review Committee two years from the completion of 2019 Committee to review the changes and their impacts, and authorize the Mayor and Clerk to sign.

Administrative or Policy Goal:

That the Ad Hoc Committee review the changes made resulting from recommendations of the 2019 committee and their impacts.

Background:

The University of Wyoming A-Team presented a Resolution to the Laramie City Council on 27 March 2018 requesting the City Council consider last point of consumption violations as part of the liquor license renewal process. This committee will be comprised of One (1) Member of City Council Appointed by the Governing Body, Laramie City Attorney, Laramie Police Chief (*Vice Chair*), Three (3) Liquor License Holders Appointed by the Governing Body, One (1) Member of the Laramie Town Gown Association (LTGA) Appointed by LTGA, One (1) Representative of the University of Wyoming Administration Appointed by U.W. President, Laramie City Clerk (*Chair*), One (1) Member of Laramie Mainstreet Alliance Appointed by LMSA Board of Directors, and One (1) Members of the University of Wyoming A-Team Appointed by A-Team.

The original Ad Hoc Committee met for a four-month period from October 2018 to February 2019, to discuss last point of consumption and other alcohol related issues and came up with eight recommendations to bring before City Council to decide what recommendations to pursue further.

City Council decided to pursue six recommendations: (1) voluntary pilot program for ID scanners, (2) to reconstitute the Ad Hoc Committee in two years, (3) increase education on "Providing a Dwelling" laws, (4) implement required tavern meetings, (5) review alcohol server training, and (6) increase the number of compliance checks.

This resolution addresses recommendation (2) to reconstitute the Ad Hoc Committee in the year 2021.
