



**Agenda Item: Resolution**

**Title: Resolution 2019-76, To Appoint Two Members to the Environmental Advisory Committee**

**Recommended Council MOTION:**

That Council move to approve Resolution 2019-76, to appoint Alec Muthig and Eric Krszjzaniek to a term expiring November 7, 2022 on the Environmental Advisory Committee, and authorize the Mayor and Clerk to sign.

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**Administrative or Policy Goal:**

To benefit from citizen representation on the Environmental Advisory Committee

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**Background:**

The Environmental Advisory Committee analyzes assigned issues, receive and analyze citizen concerns and complaints, formulate options and advise the city council and the board of county commissioners. This committee also addresses various advisory duties relating to environmental issues. Members must be qualified electors of the city or county, and shall be appointed by the joint action of City Council and the board of County Commissioners. A minimum of two (2) members shall reside within the corporate limits of the city, and a minimum of two (2) members shall reside in unincorporated Albany County.

Four current members terms expire on November 7, 2019 creating four vacancies on this committee two must reside in unincorporated Albany County. Advertisements have been published by the County and the City. Interviews were held on October 31, 2019 and recommended for appointment were made by both the City of Laramie representative and the County Commissioners. All applicants reside within City Limits so only two positions can be filled to meet the requirements of the bylaws.
