Title UW Water Line License Agreement on Bradley Street between 10th Street and 11th Street.

Recommended Council MOTION:

I move to approve the license agreement for the University of Wyoming for the two proposed water lines in Bradley Street between 10th Street and 11th Street and authorize the Mayor and City Clerk to sign.

Administrative or Policy Goal:

Resolution 2020-08, Council Goal – Maintain and Improve City Services to Residents

Background:

The University of Wyoming continues to expand their campus on Lewis Street between 9th Street and 15th Street. This license agreement allows the University to build a water service line and a water fire line between the proposed Science Initiative Building at Bradley Street and 10th Street to the Engineering Building on 11th Street and Bradley Street. This will loop the University’s water service system in the area, which will create a more stable water service in the area.
