



**Agenda Item:** Licensing

**Title: Acknowledging receipt of new floor plan for Microbrewery Permit M-8, Bond’s Brewing Company, LLC dba Bond’s Brewing.**

**Recommended Council MOTION:**

That City Council acknowledge the receipt and approval of a new floor plan for Microbrewery Permit M-8, Bond’s Brewing Company, LLC dba Bond’s Brewing to include the patio upon completion and inspection by City staff with required fencing.

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**Background:**

An updated floor plan was presented to the City Clerk’s office on May 20, 2020 for Microbrewery Permit No. M-8, Bond’s Brewing Company, LLC dba Bond’s Brewing to extend service and consumption area to the fenced in patio area being constructed behind the building. The premise location is 411 South 2<sup>nd</sup> Street, Laramie, Wyoming. The patio is located immediately adjacent to the building and is included in the current lease of the property located at 411 South 2<sup>nd</sup> Street meeting the requirements of Wyoming State Statute.

Planning Division and Code Administration have reviewed the site plan. The licensee will need to complete a mechanical or plumbing permit upon installing the fire pit in the patio area. Applicant indicated it may be a while before the fire pit is installed. An updated floor plan has been submitted to the Wyoming Liquor Division as well.

**WY § 12-5-201. Location, regulation and restrictions as to place of sale; inspections.**

(a) Except as otherwise provided in this section, the principal place in which alcoholic liquor and malt beverages are sold under a license shall be located in the licensed building for which the license is issued and as approved by the licensing authority. Alcoholic beverages may be served only in the licensed building and in an immediately adjacent fenced or enclosed area as approved by the local licensing authority. This adjacent area shall not be in another building. The licensing authority shall, as often as necessary, inspect the licensed building and adjacent areas where alcoholic beverages are served to ensure that the licensee is in compliance with sanitation and fire hazard requirements and other applicable laws.

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**Legal/Statutory Authority:**

LMC 5.09.130.A. Business entity licensees and permittees shall advise city council within thirty days in writing of any change in the information in any application required under this chapter. The city clerk shall provide the council a copy of the notification of change.
