Title: Resolution 2020-33, Fiscal Year 2021 Budget Appropriations

Approve Resolution No. 2020-33 making appropriations and authorizing expenditure of funds to cover expenditures of the City of Laramie, Wyoming for all funds for the fiscal year of July 1, 2020 to June 30, 2021 and authorize the Mayor and City Clerk to sign.

**Background:**

As required by Wyoming Statute, the City Manager prepared and filed with the City Council prior to May 15, 2020, a tentative city budget together with a budget message in explanation of the recommended budget, for all funds for the 2020-2021 fiscal year (ending June 30, 2021).

The proposed budgets were duly entered in the City Council’s record with electronic copies and made available for public inspection at the Office of the City Clerk, and on the City of Laramie website.

Notice of public hearing on the budget together with the summary of the budget and required notices concerning mill levy and expenditures, was published in the *Laramie Boomerang*, a legal newspaper published and of general circulation in Albany County, on May 29, May 31, and June 3, 2020 as required by law. As allowed by Wyoming Statute 39-13-104 (c), the FY 2021 General Fund budget includes a property tax levy of 8 mills projected to collect approximately \$1,950,000. A public hearing is being held this evening at 6:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers of City Hall, 406 Ivinson, at which time any and all persons interested may appear and be heard respecting the proposed budget.

City of Laramie staff and elected officials held five work sessions on April 14, April 28, May 12, May 13, and May 20 and two special meetings on May 12 and May 20, 2020 to hear presentations, gather information, make inquiries, review, and change the recommended budget.
