Title: Amendment #1 to the Professional Services Agreement for the B2 and Bill Nye Sanitary Sewer Design

Recommended Council MOTION:

I move to approve an amendment for the B2 and Bill Nye Sanitary Sewer Design Professional Services Agreement with Sunrise Engineering to include additional water, wastewater and roadway design for a total amendment amount of \$117,800.00 and a contingency of \$11,780.00 for a total amendment of \$129,580.00 and approve a FY 2021 budget amendment of \$50,000.00 to fund the Bill Nye Waterline design and authorize the Mayor and City Clerk to sign.

Administrative or Policy Goal:

City Council Goals: Goal D, Maintain and Improve Municipal Infrastructure

Background:

A Request for Qualifications (RFQ) was issued and proposals were received on May 8, 2019. City Council approved the award of the Professional Services Agreement to Sunrise Engineering on June 18, 2019.

The Professional Services Agreement included the design of a sanitary sewer main within the proposed Bill Nye Avenue, the design of improvements to the existing B-Line that runs parallel to Spring Creek between Corthell Road and 9th Street, and a connection between the previously mentioned lines along 19th Street.

Through the sanitary sewer design process, Sunrise Engineering has determined 19th Street is the best available alignment to connect the Bill Nye and B2 sewer mains. The City of Laramie has budgeted projects for roadway improvements and water line improvements to accompany the existing sanitary sewer project to address the entire roadway at one time.

The second portion of this amendment is to adjust the existing water main along the proposed Bill Nye alignment. Through the design process WYDOT has completed grading plans and has determined the existing waterline will need to be adjusted vertically to maintain a line that is deep enough not to be susceptible to freezing and shallow enough to easily maintain.

A cost proposal was requested from Sunrise Engineering as they have already completed work in these areas that give them in-depth knowledge of the existing conditions. Amending the existing Professional Services Agreement will reduce duplicated design work resulting in a more affordable product.
