3. WORK SESSION: Public Art in City Code

Joseph Shahidi, Associate Planner provided a PowerPoint presentation on public art in lieu of landscaping and requested input from Council.

Council discussed the options listed within the presentation that included: a) leave requirements as is, b) add code which provides quantitative standards for public art on private property, c) create review committee to create formal acceptance process for landscaping substitution, d) create an art-in-lieu fee, and e) require public art on all new development or select overlay zones.

Council would like to continue looking at the options orange (b) through blue (e).

Staff will begin drafting options that will be presented at a future meeting.

4. WORK SESSION: Code Review of City Recycling Requirements

Joseph Associate Planner provided a PowerPoint presentation related to LMC 15.14.050.I.3. requiring public recycling drop off-sites for subdivisions platted with 25 lots or greater.

Council is concerned with reducing recycling requirements.

Council would generally like to see other options for keeping the recycling program.

City Manager will further analyze the cost increase for providing other recycling options to larger subdivisions other than the standards recycling bins.

Gabriel- Albany County Tourism Board, Historic Preservation.


