AN ORDINANCE AMENDING LMC 1 REGARDING COURT AUTOMATION FEE
BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LARAMIE:

Section 1. That LMC 1.24-050 – Court Costs.– shall be amended to read as follows:

- A. The Municipal Court Judge shall impose court costs upon a guilty plea of finding of violations of municipal code (W.S 5-6-108, W.S 5-6-204)
 - a. Ten dollars court costs
 - b. Court automation costs and the portion retained by the city solely for the purpose of defraying costs and expenses related to establishing and maintaining an electronic citation system shall be set by resolution. The balance of the fee will be submitted to the state to comply with the requirements of the judicial systems automation account.
- B. No Costs shall be imposed on Defendants
 - a. Acquitted or not found guilty after a trial of the merits
 - b. Parking violations of the Laramie Municipal Code

Section 2. That this ordinance shall become effective upon its passage and approval.
