RESOLUTION 2020-10**

**A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION TO THE  
WYOMING BUSINESS COUNCIL, BUSINESS READY COMMUNITY GRANT AND  
LOAN PROGRAM FOR AN ENHANCEMENT GRANT ON BEHALF OF THE  
GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF LARAMIE FOR THE PURPOSE OF INSTALLING  
WAYFINDING SIGNAGE AND OTHER STREETScape IMPROVEMENTS IN KEY CORRIDORS IN  
THE COMMUNITY.**

**WHEREAS**, the purpose of this project is to make multiple street-level enhancements designed to convey that Laramie is a vibrant welcoming community that is “open for business” and ready to greet visiting tourists, attract and retain workforce and businesses alike, and;

**WHEREAS**, the Governing Body of the City of Laramie desires to participate in the Business Ready Community Grant and Loan Program to assist in financing this project, and;

**WHEREAS**, the Governing Body of the City of Laramie will seek a grant in an amount not to exceed \$480,000, and;

**WHEREAS**, the Governing Body of the City of Laramie plans to provide cash match in the estimated amount of \$120,000 to this Business Ready Community Grant and Loan Program Enhancement project from the following source(s): the City of Laramie, Laramie Main Street Alliance, Laramie Chamber Business Alliance, Albany County Tourism, University of Wyoming and other partners that may participate in this application, and;

**WHEREAS**, the City of Laramie held a public hearing on February 4, 2020 to solicit testimony from citizens, and gave full consideration to all comments received, and;

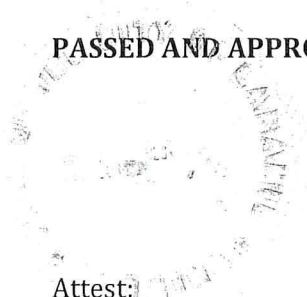
**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF LARAMIE:**

**Section 1.** That forgoing all recitals are incorporated in and made part of this resolution by this reference.

**Section 2.** That the City Council supports the filling of a grant application in the amount of \$480,000 be submitted to the Wyoming Business Council for consideration of assistance in funding the wayfinding signage and other streetscape improvements in key corridors in the community.

**Section 3.** That City Manager Janine Jordan is hereby designated as the authorized representative of the City of Laramie to act on behalf of the Governing Body on all matters relating to this grant application.
