RESOLUTION 2020-24**

A RESOLUTION SUSPENDING CODE OF CONDUCT RULE 1. AND 2.10 TO ALLOW COUNCIL MEMBERS TO ATTEND COUNCIL MEETING BY TELEPHONE OR WEB CONFERENCING WITH COMPENSATION DURING THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC WITHOUT IT COUNTING TOWARD THE ANNUAL FIVE MEETING ALLOWANCE

**Whereas**, Council for the City of Laramie, Wyoming (“Council”) adopted Rules of Procedure and Code of Conduct of City (“Council Rules”); and,

**Whereas**, the Council Rules reflect current and best practices in the City of Laramie Rules of Procedure and Code of Conduct of City Council; and

**Whereas**, the Statewide Public Health Orders prohibit gathering of 10 people or more; and

**Whereas**, the City in an effort to protect the health of our elected officials, staff, and residents have begun to attend meetings using telephone and web-conference to reduce.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF LARAMIE, WYOMING:

**Section 1.** That the following suspension of Code of Conduct Rule 1. and 2.10 to allow council members to attend council meeting by telephone or web conferencing with compensation during the COVID-19 pandemic without it counting toward the annual five meeting allowance.

**Section 2.** This shall be effective and retroactive starting March 1, 2020 and until Public Health Orders restricting gatherings of 10 people or more has been lifted or expires.
