

RESOLUTION NO. 2020-30

**A RESOLUTION ALLOWING CURRENT LOW-INCOME PARTICIPANTS TO
EXTEND ENROLLMENT WITHOUT 2020 REAPPLICATION**

WHEREAS, the Governor's Covid-19 protocol with support of the City of Laramie Council and Management team have supported the public service closure to public walk-in customer service to City Hall and social distancing in combination with Federal Agencies minimizing customer service could cause hardships for qualifying individuals to obtain adequate supporting documentation; and

WHEREAS, Laramie Municipal Code 13.44.090 requires participants to demonstrate current enrollment in a federal program in which low-income is a necessary qualification, plus the requirement to reapply each year by the first of June with proof of federal program qualifications; and


WHEREAS, The City of Laramie has enrolled approximately twenty-three (23) participants in the low-income affordable municipal services rate as per Ordinance 13.44.090 of which qualify for a monthly reduction of thirty-seven dollars and fifty-eight cents toward the Municipal Services bill.

NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF LARAMIE, WYOMING RESOLVES:

Section 1: That the foregoing recitals are incorporated in and made a part of this Resolution by this reference.

Section 2: That the City Council hereby adopts and approves the current qualified low-income individuals to continue on the program without providing reapplication documentation until May of 2021.
