RESOLUTION 2020-62

RESOLUTION APPOINTING TWO MEMBERS TO THE MONOLITH RANCH
ADVISORY COMMITTEE FOR THE CITY OF LARAMIE, WYOMING

WHEREAS, through Resolution 2008-83, the Monolith Ranch Advisory Committee was formed for the preservation of water rights on the Monolith Ranch; sound agricultural practices are necessary to protect and show increased beneficial use of the Dowlin Ditch rights for future transfer of agricultural water rights to municipal rights; drought conditions and water demands are increasing across Wyoming and across the West due to climate change; and the City of Laramie has an unprecedented water supply in the Dowlin Ditch priority water rights on the Laramie River; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 2017-37 specifies appointments serve a three (3) year term ending October 31st of the appropriate year; and

WHEREAS, Anthony Hoch and Jason Sherwood were each appointed to serve terms expiring October 31, 2020; and

WHEREAS, two (2) vacancies exist for terms of three (3) years each expiring October 31, 2023 and City Council shall fill the vacancies pursuant to Section 15.04.040 of the Laramie Municipal Code; and


WHEREAS, a four-week advertising period and subsequent interviews have been successfully conducted by City Council Representatives; the following candidates are recommended for approval by the governing body.

**NOW THEREFORE THE CITY COUNCIL OF LARAMIE, WYOMING,
RESOLVES:**

SECTION 1. That, City Council reappoints Anthony Hoch, whose three-year term expires October 31, 2023;

SECTION 2. That, City Council appoints William Brinegar, whose three-year term expires October 31, 2023.
