AS CITY OBSERVED HOLIDAYS.**

WHEREAS, the City has historically had a considerably reduced workload from the demands of the public during the days before the aforementioned holidays; and

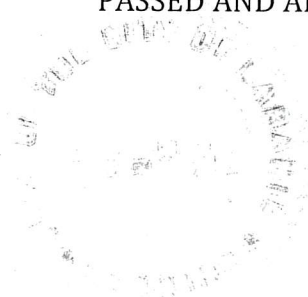
WHEREAS, there is a savings that can be realized from the closing of City Offices on the business days preceding the established City holidays; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LARAMIE, WYOMING that the City Offices shall be closed on Christmas Eve, Thursday, December 24, 2020, and New Year's Eve, Thursday, December 31, 2020, and that each day is hereby officially declared a City Holiday.
