

CITY COUNCIL RESOLUTION 2021-27

RESOLUTION OF THE LARAMIE CITY COUNCIL DECLARING A VACANCY AND APPOINTING A MEMBER TO THE URBAN SYSTEMS ADVISORY COMMITTEE FOR THE CITY OF LARAMIE, WYOMING

WHEREAS, the City of Laramie under a Cooperative Agreement established a cooperative planning procedure for the Laramie area Urban System Program. This agreement is between the City of Laramie, Albany County, The University of Wyoming and the Wyoming Department of Transportation; and

WHEREAS, Urban Systems Advisory Committee (USAC) members are appointed by Laramie City Council (3), Albany County Board of County Commissioners (2), University of Wyoming (1), Wyoming Department of Transportation (2), Laramie Traffic Safety Commission (1), Albany County Planning and Zoning Commission (1), Laramie Planning Commission (1), and Member-at-Large (1) at the concurrence of the City Council and County Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, the 1999 agreement specifies that one (1) member shall be appointed to represent the Laramie Traffic Safety Commission; and

WHEREAS, Harold Colby's USAC term will expire on August 6, 2021 and he has been recommended for reappointment to service on this committee by the Laramie Traffic Safety Commission on March 11, 2021.

NOW THEREFORE THE CITY COUNCIL OF LARAMIE, WYOMING, RESOLVES:

SECTION 1: That the City Council hereby declares that one (1) vacancy will exist on the Urban Systems Advisory Committee to be filled by a member of the Traffic Safety Commission.

SECTION 2: That Harold Colby is appointed to the Urban Systems Advisory Committee to represent the Laramie Traffic Safety Commission with a term expiring August 6, 2023.
