The City of Laramie (hereafter “City” or “COL”) will accept written submittals for:

Rotary Clubs Park at Grand View Heights Design/ Environmental Assessment/Cultural Survey/Engineering & Construction Documents

The City of Laramie (hereafter “City” or “COL”) is seeking qualified firms to assist with the development of a 7.6-acre neighborhood park located in Service Area 10 of the City of Laramie Parks & Recreation Master Plan named “Laramie Rotary Clubs Park in Grand View Heights.” Items under general consideration for this project include the gathering of information from the public, naming donors and staff for the design, environmental assessment, cultural survey, engineering and the development of construction documents for a park that will become part of the City of Laramie’s existing park system. This portion of the project is funded through donations from the Laramie Rotary Club, Laramie Sunrise Rotary Club and the 2018 voter approved Specific Purpose Tax Ballot.
