RESOLUTION 2021-37**

**RESOLUTION APPOINTING ONE MEMBER TO THE TRAFFIC SAFETY COMMISSION
FOR THE CITY OF LARAMIE, WYOMING**

WHEREAS, the City of Laramie, Wyoming (herein after referred to as "City") created the Traffic Safety Commission pursuant to Section 10.08 of the Laramie Municipal Code, to consist of seven (7) members who are appointed by the City Council for a term of three (3) years; and

WHEREAS, the Traffic Commission advises the City Council of the legislative improvements and changes requisite for the reduction of street traffic accidents and to relieve traffic congestion; and

WHEREAS, there is currently a vacancy on the Traffic Safety Commission due to a term having expired; and

WHEREAS, advertising has commenced, unceasing, since November 2020 with one application having been received during the latest publishing period and the subsequent interview having been successfully conducted by City Council Representatives; the following candidate is recommended for approval by the governing body.

NOW THEREFORE THE CITY COUNCIL OF LARAMIE, WYOMING, RESOLVES:

Section 1. That City Council appoint Melanie Arnett to the Traffic Safety Commission for a three (3) year term expiring on January 1, 2024.


