

**CITY OF LARAMIE, WYOMING
RESOLUTION 2020-61**

**RESOLUTION APPOINTING THREE MEMBERS TO THE ENVIRONMENTAL ADVISORY COMMITTEE
FOR THE CITY OF LARAMIE, WYOMING.**

WHEREAS, according to LMC 2.32, the Environmental Advisory Committee (EAC) was created to “analyze assigned issues, receive and analyze citizen concerns and complaints, formulate options and advise the city council and the board of county commissioners.” [LMC 2.32.010]; and to addresses various advisory duties relating to environmental issues [LMC 2.32.070]; and

WHEREAS the EAC consists of seven (7) members, all of whom shall be qualified electors of Albany County, and who are appointed by the joint action of the City Council and by the board of County Commissioners, a minimum of two (2) members shall reside within the corporate limits of the city, and a minimum of two (2) members shall reside in unincorporated Albany County; and

WHEREAS, one member Alec Muthig resigned and two members Ellen Currano and Rhiannon Jakopak have terms that expired which creates three vacancies on the committee;

WHEREAS, the vacant positions were advertised, all applicants have been interviewed on October 12, 2020, and appointments were recommended by the interviewing City Council and County Commissioner Representatives;

NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF LARAMIE, WYOMING, RESOLVES:




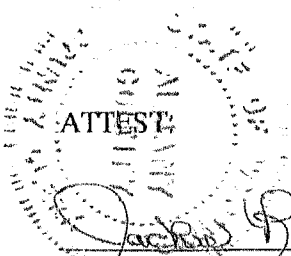
