

**CITY OF LARAMIE, WYOMING
RESOLUTION 2021-66A**

**RESOLUTION APPOINTING ONE MEMBER TO THE MONOLITH RANCH
ADVISORY COMMITTEE FOR THE CITY OF LARAMIE, WYOMING**

WHEREAS, through Resolution 2008-83, the Monolith Ranch Advisory Committee was formed for the preservation of water rights on the Monolith Ranch; sound agricultural practices are necessary to protect and show increased beneficial use of the Dowlin Ditch rights for future transfer of agricultural water rights to municipal rights; drought conditions and water demands are increasing across Wyoming and across the West due to climate change; and the City of Laramie has an unprecedented water supply in the Dowlin Ditch priority water rights on the Laramie River; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 2017-37 specifies appointments serve a three (3) year term ending October 31st of the appropriate year; and

WHEREAS, one vacancy exists for a term of three (3) years expiring October 31, 2024 and City Council shall fill the vacancies pursuant to Section 15.04.040 of the Laramie Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, a four-week advertising period and subsequent interview has been successfully conducted by City Council Representatives; the following candidate is recommended for approval by the governing body.

**NOW THEREFORE THE CITY COUNCIL OF LARAMIE, WYOMING,
RESOLVES:**

SECTION 1. That, City Council reappoints Carol Frost, whose three-year term expires October 31, 2024.
