

**CITY OF LARAMIE, WYOMING
RESOLUTION 2022 -10**

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING FEES IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE LARAMIE RENTAL HOUSING CODE, ENROLLED ORDINANCE 1802

Whereas, in Resolution 2021-12 City Council adopted policy goals for (A) holistic economic development, (A.3) preserving the community's high standards, and (A.4). improving resident housing options... including rental inspection/licensing; and,

Whereas, on January 4, 2022, Enrolled Ordinance 1802 was adopted establishing municipal code requirements for residential rental housing registration, minimum habitability standards and a tenant-landlord complaint resolution program; and,

Whereas, Enrolled Ordinance 1802 requires fees be set biennially by Resolution.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF LARAMIE, WYOMING:

Section 1. That the foregoing recitals are incorporated in and made a part of this resolution by reference;
and


Section 2. That the fees established by Enrolled Ordinance 1802 shall be as follows for calendar years 2022 and 2023, beginning January 1, 2022 through December 31, 2023.
