

**CITY OF LARAMIE, WYOMING
RESOLUTION 2022-17**

**RESOLUTION APPOINTING TWO MEMBERS TO THE DOWNTOWN
DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY BOARD FOR THE CITY OF LARAMIE, WYOMING**

WHEREAS, the Downtown Development Authority Board for the City of Laramie, Wyoming (City) is created pursuant to the authority granted under Wyo. Stat. § 15-9-203 et seq. and City Enrolled Ordinance 986; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Wyo. Stat. § 15-9-203 and City Enrolled Ordinance 986, City Downtown Development Authority Board shall consist of seven (7) members who are appointed by City Council for a term of four (4) years of which the terms shall be staggered; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Wyo. Stat. § 15-9-206 a majority of the members of the board, except any member from the governing body, shall reside, be a lessee or own real property in the downtown development district within the municipality in which the authority is located. An officer or director of a corporation having its place of business in the downtown development district shall be eligible for appointment to the board; and

WHEREAS, the City of Laramie has two vacancies due to the term-ending for Scott Crist and Candace Piscioti, on June 30, 2021; and


WHEREAS, the new members will serve a four-year term ending on June 30th, 2025 pursuant to Section § 15.9.203, City Council shall fill the remainder of each term.


NOW THEREFORE THE CITY COUNCIL OF LARAMIE, WYOMING, RESOLVES:
