

ADVERTISEMENT TO BID

Notice is hereby given that the City of Laramie, Wyoming will receive electronic bids for the furnishing of all labor, materials, tools, appliances, transportation, and services necessary to complete the **B2 Sewer Line Replacement** as called for in the Project Manual and generally described as follows:

The City of Laramie is upgrading the sewer lines south of Spring Creek from 9th Street to Corthell Road. A combination of open trench and trenchless installation methods will be utilized to install 18” PVC C900, 18” Fusible C905, and 15” PVC C900 pipe in the existing right-of-way. The sewer line will accommodate for additional development in the Southcentral Laramie area.

Electronic bids shall be submitted online until 1:00 PM Local Time, on the 5th Day of April, 2022, at which time the bids will be publicly opened and read aloud. All bids must be furnished electronically through the QuestCDN VirtuBid platform. Instructions for online bidding using QuestCDN have been attached as part of the Instructions to Bidders document. Bids which are not prepared and filed in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders may be rejected. The City reserves the right to reject any and all bids and the right to waive irregularities in bids received.

Each bid must be accompanied by a bid bond with sufficient surety, for not less than five percent (5%) of the total amount of such bid, payable to, and to be forfeited to, the City of Laramie as liquidated damages if bidder fails to enter into contract within thirty (30) days after award to them, or fails, at the time of executing the agreement, to furnish a performance bond and a payment bond each in the amount of one hundred percent (100%) of the bid. Facsimile (fax) or other copies of bonds are not acceptable. **NO BID WILL BE CONSIDERED IF NOT ACCOMPANIED BY SUCH BOND, OR IF NOT IN CONFORMANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF W.S. 15-1-113.**

A complete set of the Project Manual and Plans may be downloaded after the 11th day of March, 2022, via the City website <http://www.cityoflaramie.com/projects/>, which will lead to a QuestCDN website, where the bidder must login and pay a fee of twenty-five dollars (\$25). This login and deposit will ensure that the plan holders are identified and supplied the possible addendum and notices associated with the project.

A MANDATORY pre-bid Zoom meeting shall be held at 11:00 AM on the 24th day of March 2022. Information for the meeting will be made available to all plan holders through QuestCDN.
